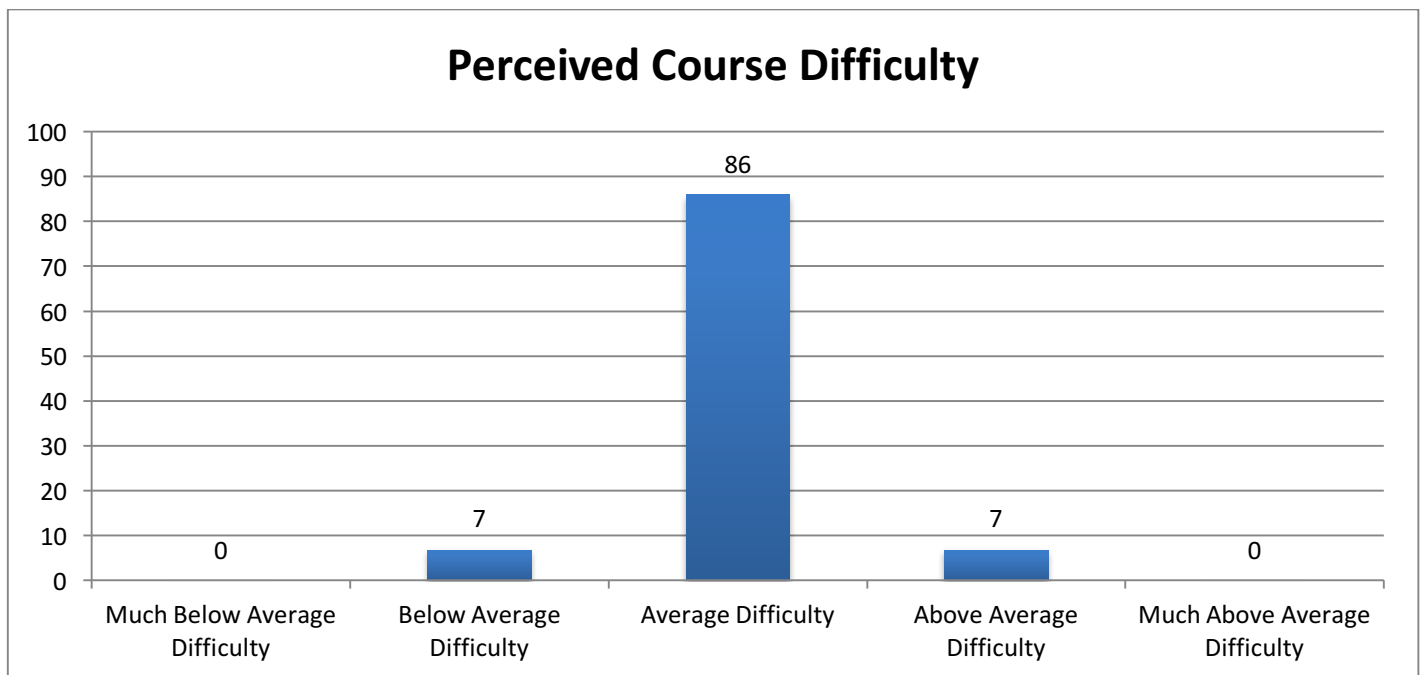
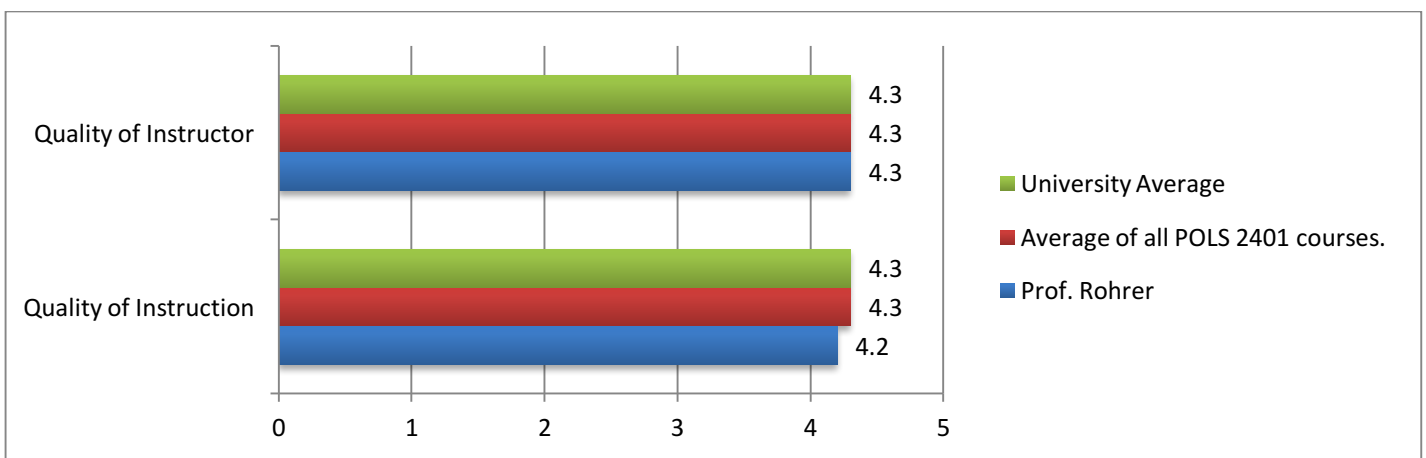


# Course Evaluation //

## Introduction to American Government

Evaluations are completed online on a voluntary basis when students check their grades at the end of each academic term. The completion rate for the evaluation was 45 percent. This completion rate indicates that the results are marginally reliable. Students respond to a series of seventeen questions assessing their professor and the quality of instruction provided. Overall my scores met UNG averages. The modal score was a B. The average percentage was an 83.
