



Course Evaluation //

Evaluations are completed online on a voluntary basis when students check their grades at the end of each academic term. The completion rate for the evaluation was 48 percent. This completion rate indicates that the results are marginally reliable. Students respond to a series of seventeen questions assessing their professor and the quality of instruction provided. Overall my scores exceeded UNG averages and the average scores of all POLS 2401 courses. At the same time this was accomplished while running a course that was considered to be rigorous. The modal score was a B. The average percentage was an 82.
