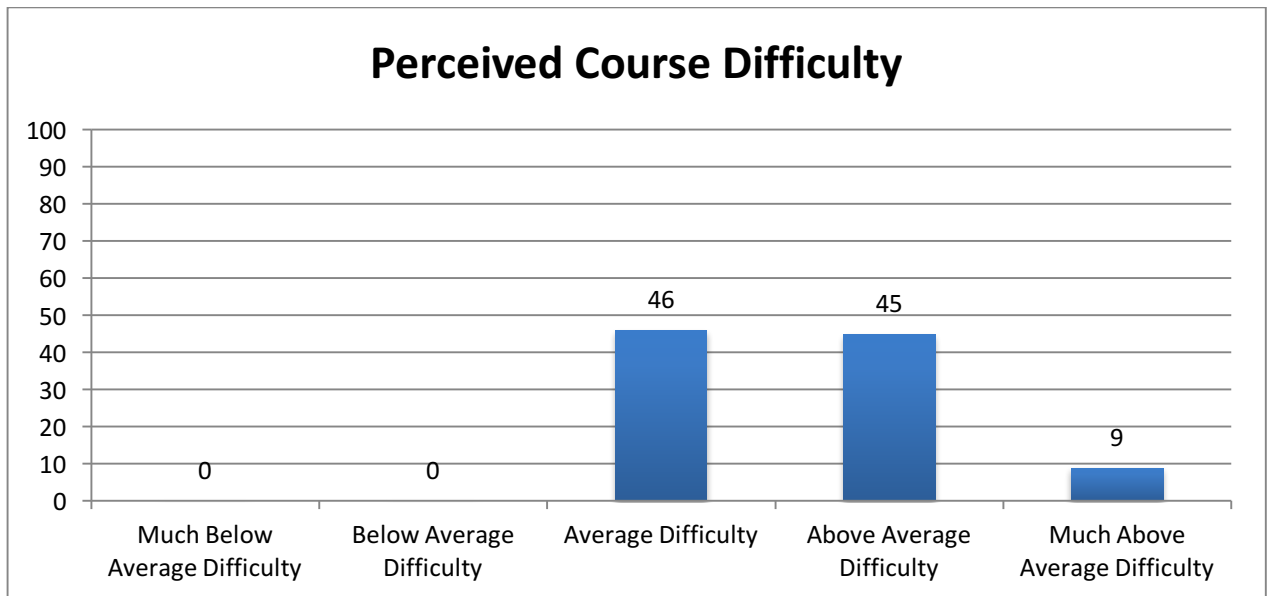
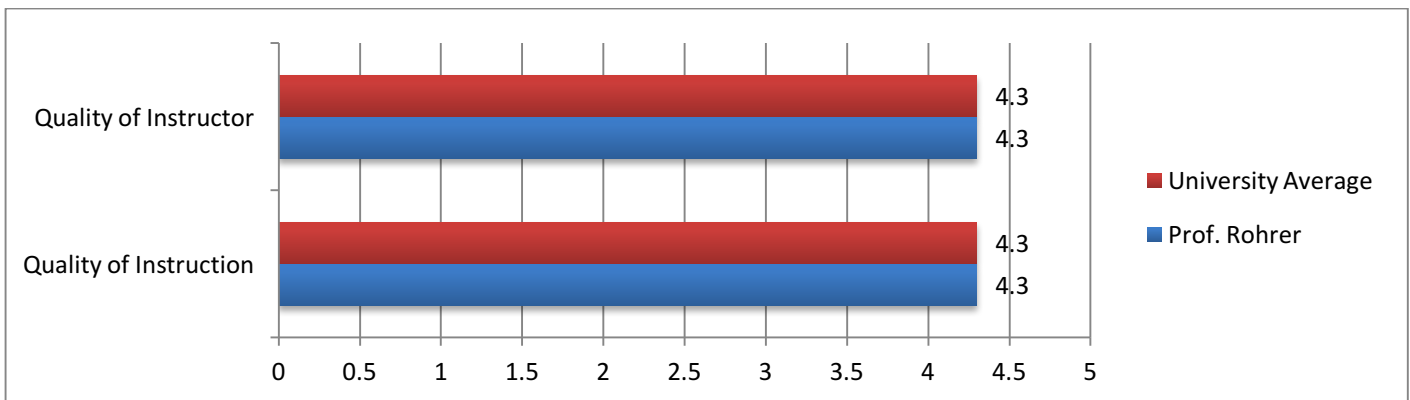


# Course Evaluation // International and Non-Governmental Organizations SP 15

Evaluations are completed online on a voluntary basis when students check their grades at the end of each academic term. The completion rate for the evaluation was 37 percent. This completion rate indicates that the results are marginally reliable. Students respond to a series of seventeen questions assessing their professor and the quality of instruction provided. Overall my scores met UNG faculty averages while delivering a course that was considered challenging. The modal grade awarded was a B.



Positive Written Comments:

My knowledge of the subject matter was considered thorough.

Breaking down complex concepts was identified as a strength.

Discussion board assignments were viewed as engaging and contributing to student learning.

Negative Written Comments:

It was noted that the last month of the course did not conform to the syllabus. This observation is correct. Several dates slid around as I was attempting to schedule two outside speakers.
