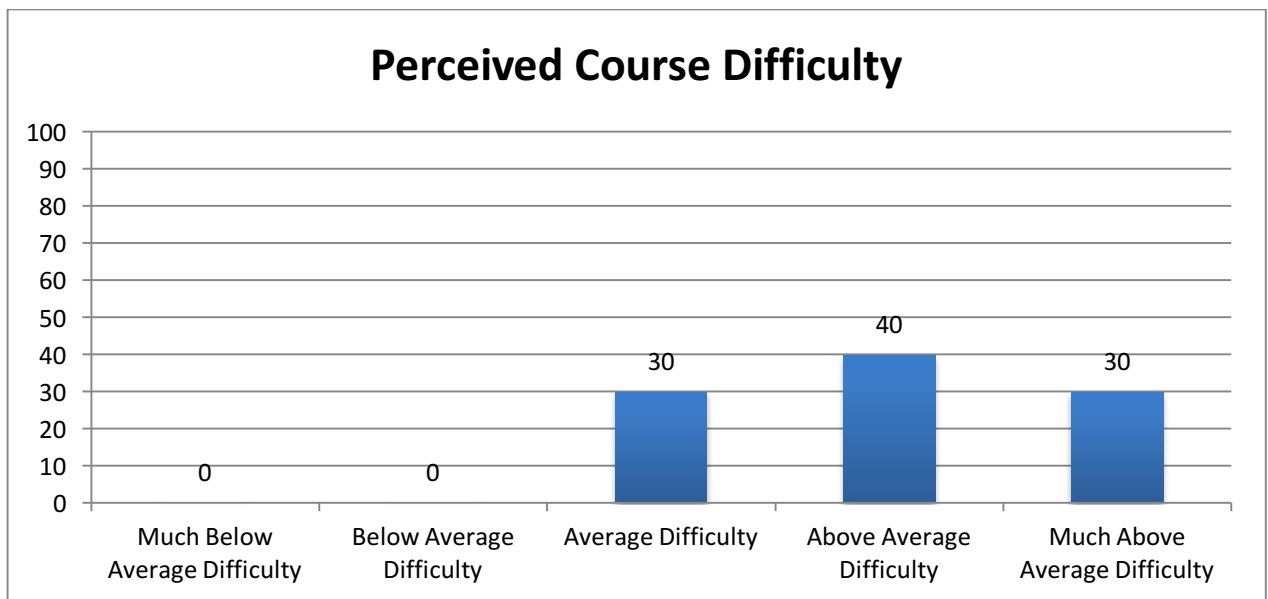
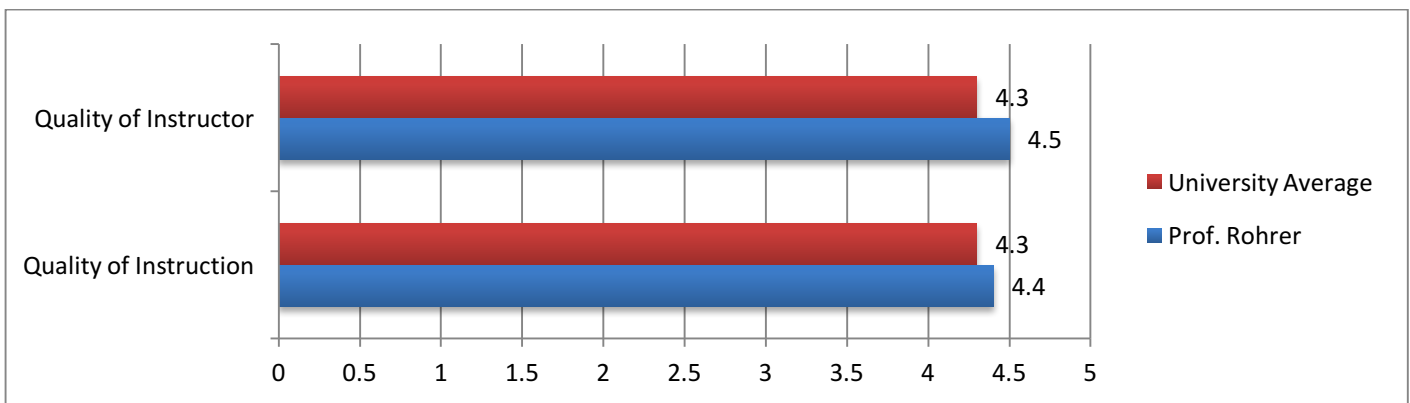


Course Evaluation //

Evaluations are completed online on a voluntary basis when students check their grades at the end of each academic term. The completion rate for the evaluation was 27 percent. This completion rate indicates that the results are marginally reliable. Students respond to a series of seventeen questions assessing their professor and the quality of instruction provided. Overall my scores met or exceeded UNG faculty averages while delivering a course that was considered to be challenging. The modal grade awarded was a B. The average percentage score was an 81.
