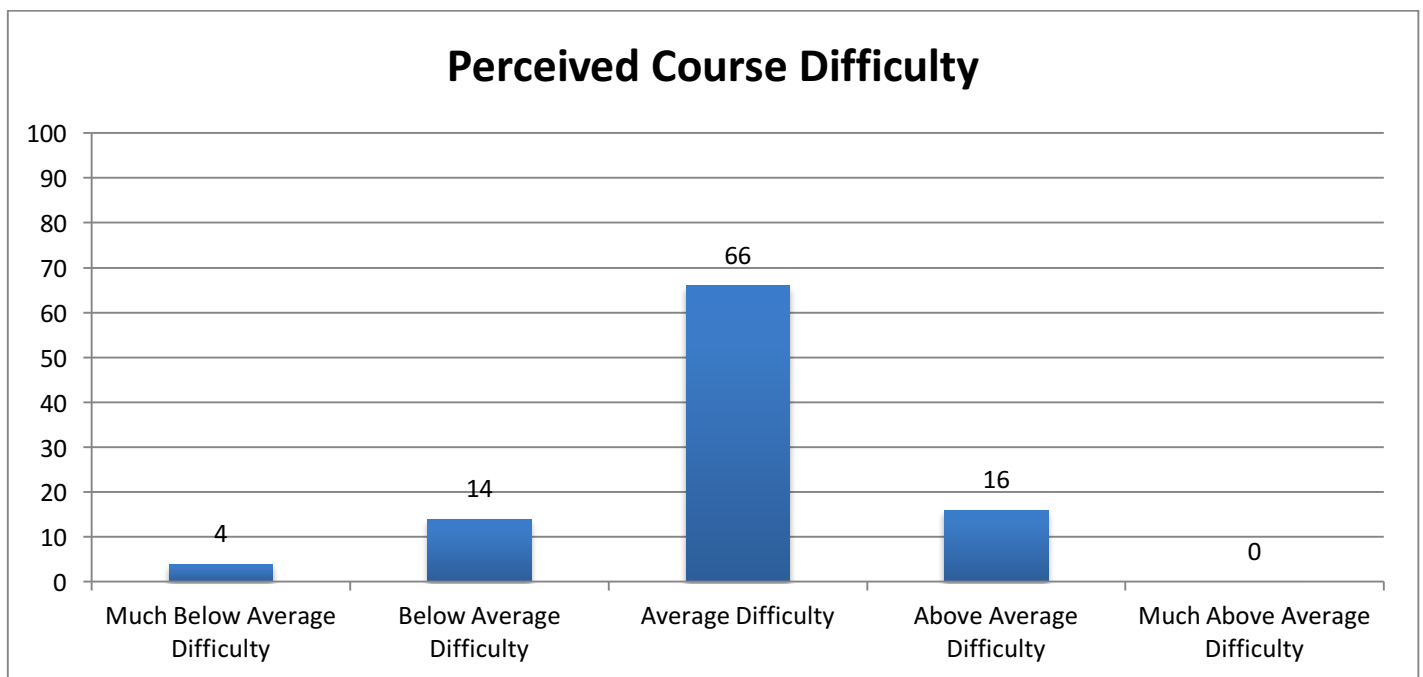
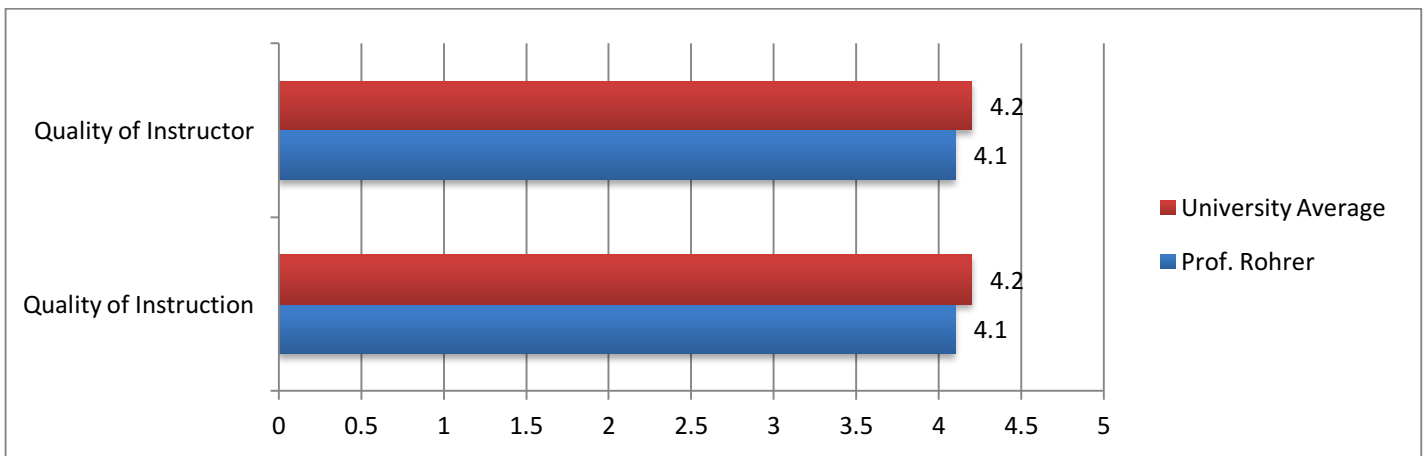


# Course Evaluation //

## Introduction to Comparative Politics – FA 14

Evaluations are completed online on a voluntary basis when students check their grades at the end of each academic term. The completion rate for the evaluation was 50 percent. This completion rate indicates that the results are marginally reliable. Students respond to a series of seventeen questions assessing their professor and the quality of instruction provided. Overall my scores met UNG faculty averages. The difficulty of the class was perceived to be average. The modal grade awarded was a B. The average percentage score was an 82.
